We are delighted to invite you to recommend a talented, current 8th and 9th grade Foster Youth to participate in the First Star UCLA Bruin Guardian Scholars Academy.

The First Star UCLA Bruin Guardian Scholars Academy (BGSA) is a free, comprehensive four-year college access program for youth in foster care. BGSA offers a 2-4 week residential summer academy where youth receive academic support, enrichment, and encouragement needed to assist them in becoming competitive college applicants. The program engages a cohort students in a variety of fun and active learning opportunities that include academic courses for college credit, independent studies, social and cultural activities, field trips, service learning and recreational activities. In addition to the summer immersion program students will receive individual support and mentoring throughout the academic year through their participation in monthly Saturday Academies.

- A) Los Angeles County Foster youth with an open DCFS Case.
- B) Currently in 8th (LAUSD schools preferred)

La Academia First Star UCLA Bruin Guardian Scholars (BGSA) es un programa para jóvenes que forma parte del sistema de cuidado del condado de Los Ángeles. El programa es gratuito. Este programa brinda información especializada para cada grado escolar sobre la educación universitaria y ofrece la oportunidad de experimentar como es la vida de un estudiante universitario. El formato básico del programa consiste de una variedad de actividades de aprendizaje, tales como cursos académicos para obtener créditos universitarios, estudios independientes, actividades sociales y culturales, excursiones, servicio comunitario, y actividades recreativas. We encourage all current 8th and 9th grade students involved with and impacted by the foster care system in Los Angeles to apply.

What happens after submission?

After the deadline, all complete applications will be reviewed by First Star and UCLA staff through a comprehensive selection process. Selected applicants will be contacted for an inperson interview. Notification of acceptance into the program will begin early April. There will be a <u>mandatory caregiver/student orientation</u> on *Saturday April 25th 2019*, for those accepted into the program.
